
2026 Menomonee Falls Parade and Fireworks General Information

The Independence Day parade in Menomonee Falls will take place on **Friday, July 3, 2026, at 7:00 pm**. The Village will also be hosting the traditional fireworks display on the evening of Friday, July 3, 2026, near the Menomonee Falls High School.

The Independence Day parade will begin with the closing of STH 175/Appleton Ave at **6:00 pm**, allowing spectators to select viewing areas along the parade route. **There will be no reserving, staking, taping off, or otherwise marking off the viewing areas that are in the public right-of-way before July 3rd at 6:00 pm. The public right-of-way is the median grassy areas between the sidewalk and curb.** The annual fireworks display, sponsored by the Village of Menomonee Falls, will begin at dusk (approximately 9:00 pm) on the practice field between Menomonee Falls High School and Ben Franklin School. The streets surrounding the two schools will be closed one half hour before the fireworks. Before these roads close, pedestrians and vehicles will be allowed into this area to find a place to view the fireworks. However, the “hot zone” surrounding the fireworks display prohibits pedestrian viewing on the athletic fields and grassy areas adjacent to Titan Dr. and Franklin Dr. The Menomonee Falls High School stadium parking lot will be open for viewing fireworks. The stadium itself will **NOT** be open for the public to enter to view the fireworks.

- Carpool to this event if possible. Parking is at a premium.
- Handicap parking and viewing are available at the northeast corner of the stadium parking lot near the intersection of Woosencraft Dr. and Titan Dr. This area will be best accessed from Appleton Ave., to Woosencraft Dr., to the stadium before the road closure at **6:00 pm**.
- All emergency/police/fire services will be staged on the high school grounds.
- Please adhere to the temporary traffic control and no parking signs, as they assist with the flow of traffic and reduce the likelihood of an accident. After the fireworks, many of the surrounding intersections are right-turn only to assist with the traffic flow.
- Possession of open intoxicants in public is illegal in Menomonee Falls.
- For the safety of all spectators, the discharge of fireworks such as firecrackers and sparklers is illegal and will be strictly enforced.
- There will be portable restrooms and trash receptacles staged along the parade route. Please help with our housekeeping efforts and dispose of trash accordingly.
- The rain date for the fireworks is Sunday, July 5th. Please monitor the calendar of events on the Village website for additional details should the fireworks be canceled on July 3rd due to inclement weather.
